Speaker for the evening was **Gerald Boughner**, Jerry is a building contractor who has been flying for 38 years and is a self taught aerobatics pilot and a skilled builder of antique and aerobatics aircraft.

His first project was a Steen Skybolt that he built entirely from plans. He used a 225HP Continental engine that gave it a cruise of 140MPH. He used it in aerobatics performances and sold it some years later. He then built a Tiger Moth Palomar R. C. Kit. The Tiger Moth by the famed Dehaviland Aeroplane Company was designed in 1931 and served as a military trainer. Jerry used a Australian Jabaroo 130HP engine. That engine had a crankshaft failure while he was flying but because it had four main shaft bearings it stayed together and ran until he could fly it back to the airfield. He brought the broken crankshaft for us to inspect. Amazing! Jerry showed a DVD of some of his aerobatics performances. He had scenes from the ground and also from the cockpit. It was interesting especially some of the footage taken at Oceanside Airport taken in the early 80's. He closed his presentation with questions from our members on aerobatics and building airplanes.

The meeting was adjourned at 2110.

New California Laws effective 7/1/07

1. **Carpool lane - 1st time \$1068.50** (The \$271 posted on the highway is old). Don't do it again because 2nd time is going to be double. 3rd time triple, and 4th time license suspended.
2. **Incorrect lane change - \$380.** Don't cross the lane on solid lines or intersections.
3. **Block intersection - \$485**
4. **Driving on the shoulder - \$450**
5. **Cell phone use must be "hands free" while driving. Ticket is \$285**

6. **Passengers over 18 not in their seatbelts - both passengers and drivers get tickets.**
